

## Valedictorian and Salutatorian

- ACA awards these honors based on SAT/ACT scores.
- The student must meet a SAT score of 530 in math and 560 in reading/writing with a minimum total being 1090 or an ACT composite score of 21+.
- If students are interested in applying for these positions they can either:
  1. make note on the graduation application or
  2. send a letter/email requesting consideration

Either of these must be submitted by **Jan. 15<sup>th</sup>** with a copy of the SAT/ACT scores to the High School Director or contact the office to see if we already have a copy.
